>>> acceptable maps include: Park Maps, AAA road maps, Topographic maps, maps from Google, other maps printed from the internet
>>> just make sure that you have the maps *with* you on your trip
>>> you will need to mark the location of each photo on the map immediately after you take each photo (*it doesn't work to wait until you get home – you will forget where the photo locations were*)
- Camera** with extra film and batteries and/or extra digital memory cards
